STATE CHAMPION – HIGH JUMP



East Aurora High School Class of 2009 President, Jamario Taylor, made history on Saturday, May 30 when he earned the State Championship Title for High Jump at the IHSA Class 3A Boys Track & Field Meet held at Eastern Illinois University. With an impressive jump of 7 feet, Taylor not only defeated nearly 40 other state qualifiers, he also shattered the 31-year old high school record of 6'9" and nearly broke the state record as well.

“It’s all about having a clear vision,” said the State Champion. “On Saturday morning, my uncle asked me what my specific vision was for the day, and I told him to come back home with the state title. That vision stayed in my mind,” he said.

Jamario plans to major in Education and continue his track career at Western Illinois University in the Fall.
