

Dear Parents/Guardians and Beaupre School Community,

The Beaupre School Report Card reflects the strengths and challenges we have in educating our students. It provides you an opportunity to view the test scores from state tests, demographic information, and teacher make-up. The Beaupre staff strongly believes in providing the best education for our students through continual reflection upon these strengths and challenges. We believe that with the support from our parents and community we will continue to achieve educational excellence and reach our school improvement goals.

Beaupre School has exceeded the state performance targets and has achieved Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for 2007. The state performance targets include: 47.5% must meet or exceed state standards for reading and math on ISAT and IMAGE tests, an attendance rate of above 89%, and above 95% of students must be tested on the state tests.

Through extensive data analysis and school improvement planning, our staff has identified reading, understanding the needs of our diverse population, and WIDA implementation to be our focal points for improvement for the 2007 - 2008 school year.

Reading Improvement Activities

- On-going professional development for using data to drive instruction will guide our building focus for the year.
- Maintaining a building literacy closet to support the reading needs of our students.
- Professional development on writing as well as the use of story elements will be provided to the staff.
- Professional book studies will be facilitated to increase instructional knowledge among the staff.
- On-going assessments will help teachers guide their instruction and identify students' needs.
- Accelerated Reader incentive will continue and training for teachers will be offered.

Understanding the needs of our diverse population Activities

- Implement a school-wide discipline plan
- Improve and maintain consistent communication between office personnel and classroom teachers
- Improve and maintain communication with our parents
- Improve parental involvement with after school activities
- Continue to provide ESL classes for parents
- Provide quarterly awards to students for academic achievement and/or outstanding service.

Understanding and implementing the ILS/WIDA standards Activities:

- Present action plan for WIDA implementation and expectations to staff

- Provide Sample lesson plans that are aligned to WIDA standards
- Provide support through modeling of lessons that are aligned to WIDA standards
- Provide professional literature on effective strategies to use with ELL students

In the area of math, on-going efforts by the staff will be made to strive for excellence on the state tests. The use of the Everyday Math series will continue and teachers will support student learning through the use of best practices.

The Beaupre staff expects students to exhibit good character in school and out. A building wide Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) program has been adopted and established. Teachers will continue to teach and reward the expected behaviors of our students throughout the school.

Beaupre School will continue to work with their students' parents to meet the needs of their students. An emphasis on parental involvement will continue at our school. Efforts for school and home communication will be expected from our staff members and parents.

Beaupre students, parents, community, and staff continue to exhibit overall excellence in making our school a great place to learn. As we work together, our educational program will strengthen and students will reach their potential. Thank you for your continual support.
