I. Summer Resource Kits

Presenter: Dr. Lori Campbell

• Dr. Campbell discussed the District's Summer School Resource Plan. This summer plan was designed to establish home libraries for students K-8. K-8 students received a Scholastic Summer Reading Book Pack containing books in English and Spanish (fiction and non-fiction). Additionally, the following resources were provided: math manipulatives, literacy skills journal (writing prompts) and a family guide to literacy support for parents.
