I. Nearpod & Pear Deck Professional Development Update

• Dr. Campbell highlighted the addition to a survey to be completed after MAP testing in September. Dr. Campbell shared that the survey is a "behavior and emotional screening system designed to assist our schools with determining the behavioral strength and weaknesses of students."

III. Summer School-Summer Writing Contest

- Dr. Campbell provided a summary of 2021 Summer School participation, curricular resources, academic growth, and areas of improvements for summer programming.
- Mr. Jackson also shared some key points of our summer school. "Summer school programs offered both inperson or remote programming for students. We extended the summer school by two weeks, offering a sixweek program instead of our traditional four-week program. This allowed our school communities to provide extra instructional and social emotional support to our students. At the end of our six-week session, students had an opportunity to try something new, something we call the Book Creator. Book Creator is an educational application that students use to create their own digital online books. These digital books may be shared with others or downloaded, and students used Book Creator to participate in our Summer Writing contest. We received a total of 66 submissions, with us today are the winners of our contest. We would like to recognize the young authors who touched our hearts with their stories, for their stories are now part of us."
