Know these terms:

Clause

- A group of words that contain a subject and a verb
 - May or may not be a sentence

Phrase

- A group of words that does not contain a subject or verb
 - Prepositional phrase
 - Ex: Under the bridge
 - Over the rainbow

Rule 1:

 Use commas to separate items in a list.

- Please bring paper, pencils, pens, and sticky notes to class.
- Lisa, Lauren, Lizzie, and Louie are the Johnson's quadruplets.
- The recipe calls for spinach, ricotta, eggs, and parmesan cheese.

Rule 2:

 To separate introductory phrases, clauses, or words

 To separate dependent clauses from independent clauses

- After their walk, the dogs were exhausted.
- Yes, we will be attending the party.
- The storm was severe; therefore, many flights were cancelled.
- Because it's warm outside, we turned on the air-conditioning.
- While we were out, the package was delivered.

Rule 3:

 To set off from the sentence, clauses that add information but are not necessary.

- The new student, in the denim jacket, transferred from South Carolina.
- My Aunt Mary, who talks on the phone all day long, lives in Chicago.
- My dog Cubby, a Soft-Coated Wheaten Terrier, can jump three feet off the ground.

Rule 4:

- In dates
 - Between day and year
- For geographical locations and addresses
 - Between city and State/country
 - Between street, city, state

Rule 5

 When using quotation marks to show dialogue or cite a source

- Santa said, "Ho, ho, ho!"
- "Look!" shouted dad, "There's a bear!"
- "Go ahead. Make my day," is a famous line from a movie.
- According to the author, "4 out of 5 dentists prefer Trident gum."
- "Proper nutrition is critical," reported the dietician, Dr. Sarah Jones.
