HEALTH REQUIREMENTS NOTICE

To ensure good health for all students, the State of Illinois has mandated certain health requirements for school entrance and grade progression. This means that students will not be able to attend school until these items are presented to the school. The following is a list of these requirements.

- 1. **Pre-School / Kindergarten:** Proof of new child health examination on the appropriate state form and proof of updated immunizations. It is recommended children be screened for lead and TB. Please have the health care provider review the immunization records to ensure compliance with current requirements.
- 2. **First Grade**: If the student cannot submit documentation of the child health examination or proof of immunizations in the prior school year, the child health examination along with proof of immunizations are required for school attendance for this school year. (First time in Public School)
- 3. **Sixth Grade**: Proof of new child health examination on the appropriate state form and proof of updated immunizations. Please have the health care provider review the immunizations record to ensure compliance with current requirements.
- 4. **Ninth Grade**: Proof of new child health examination on the appropriate state form and proof of updated immunization records. Please have the health care provider review the immunizations record to ensure compliance with current requirements.
- 5. **Twelfth Grade**: Must show proof of 2 doses of meningococcal vaccine (one dose being at or after the age of 16).
- 6. **In-State Transfer Student**: Proof of child health examination on the appropriate state form and updated immunizations upon enrollment.
- 7. **Out of State Transfer**: Proof of required child health examination on the appropriate state form upon enrollment. Must present proof of updated immunizations within 30 days of registration.
- 8. **Dental Examination**: Required for all students entering kindergarten, second, sixth, and ninth grade.
- 9. **Vision Examination**: Required of all students entering kindergarten or enrolling in an Illinois public school for the first time.

Students participating in sports need to have a yearly sports physical (IHSA forms are available from the coach, school nurse or your doctor). The sports physical is **not** acceptable as the required child health examination form required for enrollment.

We ask that you please take care of this as soon as possible and return the information to your child's home school to reduce the risk of your child's education being interrupted. If you have any questions or need resources, please contact your child's home school health office for information.
