1. Go to newsela.com
2. Click “sign in” at the top, right hand corner.
3. Sign in using the following information:

4. Click the “search” tap in the top, left hand corner of the website.
5. Type in one of the assigned topics on the first page you were given (ex. Constitution, 3 Branches of Government, etc.)
6. Choose one article that relates to the topic you selected and click on it.
7. On the top, left hand side click the white box and select the LOWEST number with an L next to it (Ex. 520L)
8. Read the article.
9. After reading the article, complete the corresponding NewsELA worksheet (on the next page).
