## Kindergarten through 5th Grade Placement

District 131 offers East Aurora families a Student Acceleration process, which includes early admittance to Kindergarten and first grade, single subject (Reading and Math) acceleration. Additionally, the district offers whole grade acceleration for students who qualify. Qualifications for single subject and whole-grade acceleration are based on academic test scores, cognitive test scores (CoGAT), a developmental survey, and review of the student profile summary.
*If a student hits any of the columns in these tables, they will be eligible to enter an honors course in middle school.
