E-learning is to be used on no more than five school days per year and would count as attendance days without the need to add emergency days to the end of the school year, according to Section 10-20.56 of the School Code {105.I LCS/10-20.56}. - Devices are provided for all students in grades K-12 (iPads for K-1, Chromebooks for 2-12)
- Free internet access is available for all (hotspots available based on individual family needs)
- E-learning plans are aligned with the Illinois State Standards appropriate for the level (Illinois Early Learning and Development Standards, Common Core State Standards, etc.).
- Staff will assign work for each E-learning plan with a minimum of five clock hours of instruction (8:30am - 1:30 pm). Instruction may be provided through synchronous and asynchronous instructional models. Staff will be available via email to support students through their E-learning plans.
- Staff will receive an email regarding the expectations for e-learning and a support list of district office personnel for any additional questions or concerns.
- Students will access core curricular programs via Class Link or the District Website. Student work will be sent home electronically.
 - Preschool - teachers will email families with guidance
 - Elementary - teachers will communicate via See Saw, Google Classroom, or Class Dojo
 - Middle and High - teachers will update Google Classroom with course work
 - Credit Recovery - course work will be available for students through the Edgenuity Platform and aligned with students needs
 - Life Skills (LS) and Structured Learning Classrooms (SLC) - teachers will email work packets aligned to the student's specific IEP needs
- Students will submit their work online to provide evidence of work completion.
